Many thanks for allowing me the opportunity to read your book Arts India: Shiva in Sculptures. I enjoyed it and learned a great deal from it.

There are many strengths in your presentation: The Introduction is very clear, and the organization of the following chapters, with reference to the illustrations, makes the description and discussion easy to follow. There are many explanations of the terminology which may be unfamiliar to a Western reader. The use of italics for Indian words helps the reader know that these may be unfamiliar terms.

There are a few suggestions I have to offer which will make your next publication even better. Including a map of India, with the locations of the items in the illustrations indicated would be very helpful, especially to those who plan to travel to India. Although you have explained most of your terminology, there remain some which are unfamiliar to the average Western reader. This is a problem for the reader, and might be best solved by the inclusion of a glossary of terms at the end, or perhaps at the bottom of the page. Another suggestion I have is to include drawings or diagrams of the attributes of the gods and goddesses, so that the reader can be more familiar with them.

Again, thanks for the opportunity to read your very interesting book.
